This unique exhibit includes costumes imported from such French music productions as *Lido de Paris* and *Folies Bergère* and from Donn Arden-produced costume extravaganzas like *Hallelujah Hollywood* and *Hello Hollywood, Hello*. The engaging exhibit serves to interpret the significance of cabaret-style entertainment productions to the development of Las Vegas and illustrates the evolution of performance costume as seen on the stages of the entertainment capital of the world.
